### Rules and Regulations:

1. All entries for photography, fine arts and multi media only will be accepted from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 11, 2004.
2. Entries, for areas except baked goods, photography, fine arts and multi media will be received from 4-8 p.m. Wednesday, Sept. 15, 2004; and 2-8 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 16, 2004.
3. Baked good entries will be received from 2-8 p.m. Friday, Sept. 17.
4. All entries are limited to Frederick County residents only.
5. Exhibitors must purchase a Season Exhibitors' Pass for \$6. Each exhibitor is allowed only three entries per \$6 pass. Season passes are not transferable and will be forfeited if presented by any person other than to whom issued.
6. Exhibitors will not be permitted more than one entry for each variety or kind in any of the classes.
7. The management assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to exhibits from any cause; only upon this condition will entries be accepted.
8. All entries will remain in place until noon Sunday, Sept. 26, no exceptions. Entries will be released from noon- 5 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 26. Items not picked up within three weeks after the fair will be disposed of. All premiums will be mailed in the form of a check.
9. Senior Citizens are 70 years of age and over.
10. Exhibits must be completed within the fair year.
11. Refer to the general rules and regulations for additional information.
12. No Political Satire.

## DEPARTMENT M - BAKED GOODS

1. Judging will be based on flavor, texture and appearance.
2. All baked goods must be made from scratch unless otherwise noted.
3. Items to be placed on sturdy paper or styrofoam plate.
4. All frostings must be made from scratch.
5. No meringue pies or buttercream frostings.
6. Only enter half a cake or loaf of bread.
7. Fancy cakes and novelty cakes can be styrofoam. These cakes will not be cut.
8. Pies should be on foil pie plate.
9. The recipe must accompany all machine made breads.
10. Only 2 layer cakes.
11. Cookies should be 2 or 3 inch, no bigger, on 7 inch plate. Do not stack cookies.
12. Ingredients of recipes are strongly recommended on all items by judges.

**DEPARTMENT N - FOOD PRESERVATION**

- Jars must be clean and have rings on -- *NO RUSTY RINGS*.
- Canned fruits, vegetables, and meats must be exhibited in clear (untinted) standard canning quart or pint jars vacuumed packed with screw tops; preserves\*, jams\*, marmalades\*, butters\*, and pickles in clear (untinted) standard half-pint jars vacuumed packed with screw tops; jelly in standard jelly glasses (8 ounce) sealed with paraffin or in standard one-half pint vacuumed packed jars with screw tops (\* may be sealed with paraffin)
- No artificial coloring permitted, except jellies.
- Canned goods must have been canned since last fair, except dill pickles which may be a year old.
- Any canned goods may be opened during judging.
- NO MAYONNAISE JARS will be accepted.
- Small ribbon stickers will be used during fair for display. Upon pick up of item, exhibitors will be given regular ribbon.
- Do not fill jars to top.

3. No artificial coloring permitted, except jellies.
4. Canned goods must have been canned since last fair, except dill pickles which may be a year old.
5. Any canned goods may be opened during judging.
6. **NO MAYONNAISE JARS** will be accepted.
7. Small ribbon stickers will be used during fair for display. Upon pick up of item exhibitors will be given regular ribbon.
8. Do not fill jars to top.
