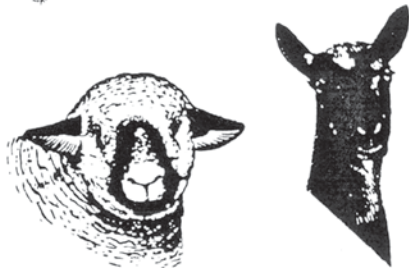

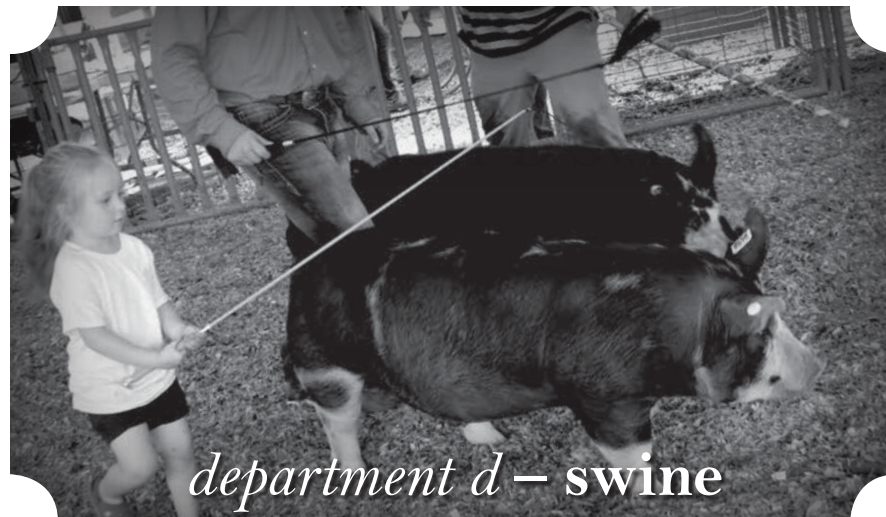

Entries must be in place by 9p.m. Friday, Sept. 21

Rules & Regulations:

1. Open only to Maryland residents.
2. An entry fee of \$5 per head, payable when entry is made.
3. Non 4-H/FFA families, farms and/or exhibitors will receive one (1) Exhibitor Season Pass with Parking for 1-3 paid entries and one (1) additional Exhibitor Season Pass with Parking for four (4) or more paid entries. Up to four (4) additional season passes may be purchased. The Exhibitor Season Pass with Parking is good for admission onto the grounds and parking in the satellite lots A, B, C, or D only.
4. Any 4-H/FFA'er wishing to exhibit in the open show on Tuesday or Wednesday must pre-register and pay the \$5 entry fee per animal. Each 4-H/FFA exhibitor will receive one (1) Exhibitor Season Pass with Parking.
5. No deductions will be made from any premiums awarded.
6. Each animal must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor. Animals sold through the 4-H Livestock sale on Thursday night are not eligible to show.
7. All transfers must be dated 30 days prior to the opening of the fair and must be signed by the secretary of the respective breed association.
8. The fair reserves the right to limit the number of pens for an individual.
9. One entry per breeder in all group classes.
10. All premium checks will be mailed to exhibitors.
11. Refer to general rules and regulations for additional information.
